Genesis Farm is a twenty-acre market and educational farm in Chapel Hill where we grow a variety of seasonal vegetables, herbs, fruits, and flowers, and care for abundant wildlife and domesticated animals. The Farm has served as a popular field-trip destination for schools in the Chapel Hill-Carrboro area, hosting over 500 visitors a year since 2007.
